

Waterfront Guest Privileges and Policies

Your Rental includes unlimited use of the yacht club launch, access to our shore facilities (to include showers and restrooms), guest privileges in the AHYC clubhouse, and use of the club dock. We accept cash and major credit cards. By securing your yacht to a guest mooring you agree to the following conditions:

1. The Atlantic Highlands Yacht Club, its officers, members, and employees are not responsible for damage caused by mooring tackle failure.
2. The owner/master of guest vessels will be held ultimately responsible for his or her vessel.
3. Guest vessels are held responsible for Federal Regulations regarding Overboard-Discharge.
4. Rafted vessels will be charged for the use of the mooring and launch service.
5. AHYC reserves the right to move any vessel at any time.
6. Guest vessels may not relocate to different moorings without authorization from AHYC.
7. Noise aboard vessels should be limited after 2300.
8. Launch-only service expires 24 hours after purchase.
9. Guests may use the club floating dock for the same period as is allotted to members (about 20 minutes). Fresh water and electric connections are available on the AHYC dock.
10. Dinghies are not permitted on the club dock.
11. Head/Shower keys are the property of the Atlantic Highlands Municipal Marina, and are on-loan to the Atlantic Highlands Yacht Club. Guests will be charged \$20 for lost or damaged keys.
12. Guests must register in the guest log when utilizing clubhouse facilities (not showers).
13. Members and Guests alike are requested to wear shoes and shirt while on the launch.

The Atlantic Highlands Yacht Club reserves the right to revoke mooring and launch privileges upon violation of any of these conditions.

Welcome to the Atlantic Highlands Yacht Club. Our launch service is here to provide you with not only transportation ashore and guest-moorings, but also with information that may assist you during your stay. We hope you enjoy the great sailing, scenery, and amenities that our area has to offer.

Atlantic Highlands is rich in maritime tradition, dating back to the voyages of Henry Hudson. Nearly three hundred years later, our village served as a coastal resort accessible by steamer from New York City. Feel free to come ashore to explore the Victorian homes of that era, or enjoy a pleasant walk along waterside trails. The downtown area is an easy walk from the yacht club; it offers a wide variety of restaurants, food stores, a Laundromat, chandlery, and public transportation.

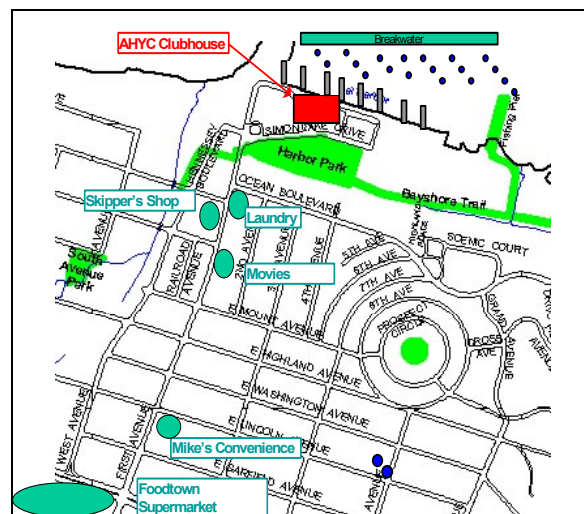
AHYC was established by a group of local boating enthusiasts in 1953. Our newly renovated Club House is located above the Shore Casino Restaurant off Pier 4. We are open year round hosting many social events ranging from casual cocktail parties to formal dinner dances. In the summer the Club is open Tuesday thru Sunday for dinner service. There is always something going on at the Atlantic Highlands Yacht Club. Also, feel free to visit our “Ship’s Store” while relaxing in the club.

Our launch drivers monitor VHF FM 09 and dock phone 732-291-3232. The AHYC Clubhouse phone number is 732-291-1118. We hope the “Frequently Asked Questions” in this guide will answer most of your inquiries. Please address any additional questions, comments, or concerns to our launch staff.

Going Ashore: Our Launch utilizes Pier 4 for its operations. To visit the AHYC clubhouse, walk up the gangway from our dock and go to the end of the Pier. AHYC is on the second floor of the Shore Casino Restaurant, the large building at the end of the pier. Enter through the first set of glass doors; proceed through the wooden door and up the stairs.

The launch drivers will be happy to loan you a key to access shower and restroom facilities. One set of showers is located on the eastern side of the Shore Casino/AHYC building on the ground level. The other set of showers is located on the eastern side of the harbor just behind the security checkpoint leading into the storage yard. The Municipal Harbor also maintains public restrooms, which do not have showers or require a key.

On the western side of the harbor, you can find tennis courts, a gazebo, and a small park/playground. Sunday evening concerts are held at the gazebo. Continue walking west and you will find First Avenue, our main street. There you will find restaurants, marine supplies, a hardware store, Laundromat, cinema, and most shopping to suit your needs. The AHYC clubhouse and Dock Office each maintain binders containing local restaurant menus and address/phone numbers for local businesses and medical providers.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Operations

What channel do you monitor? We monitor VHF FM 09 and 732-291-3232 during hours of operation.

When do you operate? We operate seven days a week from May through October. See back cover for our full schedule.

Where is everything? The Launch Dock Office and AHYC clubhouse each maintain binders to point you to where local services are.

The Harbor:

When is the fuel dock open? The harbor fuel dock is located on Pier 6. They are open daily (usually 0700-1800) and monitor VHF 09. Pump-out and Ice are available on the fuel dock.

If I take my dinghy ashore, where can I leave it? We recommend that you use the launch, however transient dinghy docks are available on the western side of Pier 8 (the eastern most pier in the harbor).

Where can I dispose of my trash? Garbage and recycling bins are located at the shoreward end of Pier 4 (where our launch lands).

Where can I buy ice? Ice is available from Pete's Bait and Tackle (the western most pier in the harbor) during normal business hours. Ice is available 24 hours a day from the Harbor Security at their office behind the main Harbor Office, or during business hours on the fuel dock.

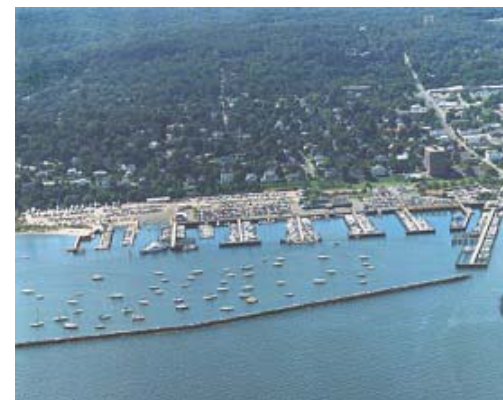
Can I haul my boat out? If you need to haul your boat, the Municipal Harbor has a Travelift. Contact the Harbor Office for details.

Is there a local diver? Local divers are regularly available; ask our launch staff for more information.

Is there a marine store nearby? The Skipper Shop is the closest on First Avenue, or West Marine is a five-minute cab ride away.

How long can we stay? Ice arrives in December, but the hearth will be warm in the club!

Where are the showers? Private showers are located on the eastern side of the Shore Casino Restaurant just across the driveway from the shoreward end of Pier 4. Remember to obtain a key from our launch staff.



Shopping and Other Needs:

Where can I buy provisions? There is a supermarket on the corner of First Avenue and Highway 36 (15 minute walk). Convenience stores are along the way.

Food Service at the Club? Dinner service is available in the club dining room Tuesday through Sunday after 1730.

Are there any local restaurants? Definitely! There are many local restaurants that we are sure you will enjoy. Please ask our launch operators for a directory of menus and phone numbers to help you decide.

Where can I connect to the Internet?

The public library at Town Hall on First Ave offers Internet access. Remember to visit ahyc.net!

Laundromat? This is the first business on the left on First Avenue. (Across from Skipper Shop.)

New York City? The easiest way to get to New York City is via the SeaStreak Ferries that leave from Frank's Pier and land in NYC at Pier 11 and East 34th Street. Their ticket office is located at the western end of the harbor. SeaStreak offers transportation to both Yankee and Shea stadiums.

New Jersey Transit (NJT) Trains? Middletown Station is 15 minutes away by cab. These trains run from 34th St Penn Station, NY to Bay Head, NJ. New Jersey Transit Trains stop at Newark Airport (EWR).

Amtrak trains? You may connect to Amtrak's rail service via NJT at Newark, or 34th Street Penn Station, NY.
